This is to certify that Mahmoud Dakhel, M.D. was a nuclear medicine resident at St. Vincent's Catholic Hospital and Medical Center of New York, Manhattan during the period July 2000 – June 2002. During this period, he received his residency training under my supervision.

Dr. Dakhel has completed the training requirements including performing supervised administration of therapeutic doses routinely done at our department under my supervision as chief of nuclear medicine service and the authorized user. This includes a range of **supervised cases completed by Dr. Dakhel during his residency as follows:**

1. More than three Oral Administrations of Sodium I-131 with activities equal to or less than 33 millicuries (and greater than 20 microcurries)
2. More than three parenteral administration of bet-emitting or photon emitting radionuclides with photon energies 150 kev for which a written directive is required, including more than three ceases of Strontium-89 Metastron and more than three cases of Samarium-153 Quadramat.
