PROGRAM SCOPE

The licensee possesses two gauges each containing a nominal 50 millicuries. One gauge is used in a soybean extraction process and the other in bio-diesel production. The licensee was not authorized to perform service or remove the gauges; these services are performed by the manufacturer.

Performance Observations

During the inspection, the inspector reviewed the licensee's security of the gauges and performed independent radiation measurements; no abnormal issues were identified. The inspector interviewed the radiation safety officer and noted that he had adequate knowledge to ensure the safe use of the devices. The inspector reviewed the licensee's documentation associated with leak tests, shutter tests and inventories; no abnormal issues were noted.
