PROGRAM SCOPE

The licensee possesses four Troxler gauges and employs five gauge operators. The licensee had not used the gauge during the inspection. The licensee primarily uses the gauges between April and November each year at temporary job sites in the Kansas City area.

Performance Observations

The inspector interviewed the RSO and a gauge operator and found that the licensee staff had adequate knowledge to ensure safe use of the gauge. The inspector reviewed the licensee's leak test records, inventory, transportation documentation and dosimetry records; no abnormal issues were identified. The licensee demonstrated the transportation of the gauge; no abnormal issues were noted. The licensee properly secured each gauge in accordance with NRC regulations..
