SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF PUBLIC SCOPING MEETING CONDUCTED RELATED
TO THE REVIEW OF THE GRAND GULF UNIT 3 COMBINED LICENSE
APPLICATION

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff conducted environmental scoping meetings related to the review of the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station (Grand Gulf) Unit 3 combined license (COL) application submitted by Entergy Operations, Inc. Two public meetings were held on Thursday, June 19, 2008 at the Port Gibson City Hall in Mississippi. Over 40 people attended the afternoon session, and approximately 55 were in attendance during the evening meeting. The participants included members of the NRC staff, NRC contractors from Pacific Northwest National Laboratory, representatives from Entergy, the news media, state agencies, local government officials, local residents and other members of the public. Public comments and questions were mainly focused on the COL process including the ESBWR reactor design certification process and schedule, environmental justice, socioeconomics and emergency preparedness.

The purpose of the meeting was to provide the public with an opportunity to participate in the environmental scoping process through comments on issues the attendees believed the NRC staff should consider while preparing the supplemental environmental impact statement for the Grand Gulf Unit 3 COL application. During the meeting the NRC staff presentation outlined the overall licensing process under 10 CFR Part 52; provided a description of the National Environmental Policy Act review process; discussed the environmental requirements outlined in 10 CFR Part 51; and addressed how these requirements would be implemented during the COL review.

Enclosure 3 contains the meeting Agenda and the handout from the Open House portion of the meeting. Enclosure 4 is a copy of the NRC slide presentation.
