Enclosed is Amendment No. 16 to your NRC Material License No. 21-02037-03 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in bold font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions.

Please note that, at this time I approved the addition of your new location of use at 900 Old Farm Road, Ishpeming, Michigan. However, your letter dated April 7, 2008, was minimally adequate and did not contain some of the information we need to fully approve of the location of use. Since your letter did not specify which materials were to be used at the new location of use, I assumed that only materials in 10 CFR 35.100 and 35.200 would be used there. In the future, please clearly specify exactly which materials or modalities of use you expect to use at a proposed location of use.

Within 30 days of the date of this letter, please resubmit your facility diagram, including the information in NUREG 1556, Vol. 9, Rev. 2, Item 8.15, Item 9 and Appendix C, Item 9, "Facility Diagram," limited to the elements that are appropriate for the proposed license. A simple hand-drawn diagram(s) is best, indicating the direction of north, the functional identity of all areas immediately adjacent to the new space, the proposed layout of the space, the scaled of the diagram or the actual dimensions of the rooms, and so on.

Please do not submit blueprints or copies of blueprints. Here are links to these sections on our webpage:



You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
