Dear Dr. Jain:

This is in reference to your application dated June 2, 2008 requesting to renew Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 29-30463-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

In your application dated July 1, 1998, you committed to establishing and implementing many of the Model Procedures published in NRC Regulatory Guide 10.8, Revision 2, "Guide for the Preparation of Applications for Medical Use Programs." This guide was published in August 1987 and was designed for use with the NRC's medical regulations that existed in 10 CFR Part 35 at that time. On April 24, 2002, NRC published new medical regulations in 10 CFR Part 35. These regulations became effective on October 24, 2002. Concurrent with the issuance of the new medical regulations, NRC published NUREG-1556, Volume 9, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance About Medical Use Licenses" Volume 9, Revision 1 was issued May 2005. As specified in Appendix AA of NUREG-1556, Volume 9, Regulatory Guide 10.8, Revision 2 is superseded and should no longer be used. Additionally there has been six letters which have modified your original application.

Please resubmit your renewal application in full using the guidance in NUREG-1556, Volume 9, Revision 1, in preparing your license renewal application. You will note that new Part 35 and this guidance generally do not require the submission of detailed procedures during the licensing process. As detailed in NUREG-1556, Vol. 9, in many cases a licensee is required only to supply a statement regarding the development, implementation, and maintenance of written operating and emergency procedures. Appendix C of NUREG-1556, Volume 9, should be helpful in identifying the information required by NRC to process your request for license renewal.
