I am responding to your letter of April 11, 2008, by which you submitted to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a petition for rulemaking (PRM) on behalf of the Strategic Teaming and Resource Sharing (STARS) Integrated Regulatory Affairs Group, requesting an administrative change to amend Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), Part 50.36, "Technical Specifications" to correct a paragraph numbering conflict introduced by a final rule for new plants (72 FR 49351; August 28, 2007, Part 52, "Licenses, Certifications, and Approvals for Nuclear Power Plants"). We docketed your petition as PRM-50-91.

The NRC has determined that the issue raised by PRM-50-91 can be resolved through an administrative rulemaking which restores the original paragraph designations. Accordingly, the NRC is restoring the original paragraph designations in a final rule and including § 50.36(c) as adopted in the 2007 Part 52 final rulemaking as new § 50.36(a)(2). This final rule closes the docket on PRM-50-91.
