In response to the NRC letter dated May 30, 2008, please find the response to the Severity Level IV violation regarding failure to monitor radiation dose for one employee at St. Luke's Regional Medical Center.

Reason for the violation: The worker is a contract employee who had a previously issued monitoring badge from this licensed facility. That badge was discontinued, and the employee instead wore a monitoring badge issued by another licensed facility, as he was working at multiple facilities.

Corrective steps that have been taken and results achieved: A monitoring badge was re-issued to the employee by this licensed facility.

Corrective steps that will be taken to avoid further violations: Contract employees will be required to wear badges issued by St. Luke's instead of wearing badges issued by other facilities.

Date when full compliance was achieved: July 1, 2007.
