The U.S Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff reviewed the Integrated Safety Analysis Annual Update, submitted via letter SPM-07-005 dated January 30, 2007, as well as Global Nuclear Fuel-Americas, LLC's Change Request Summary for calendar years 2006 and 2007 submitted via letter SPM-08-012 dated February 26, 2008.

Our review has determined that all the facility changes we reviewed for 2006 were appropriately made in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 70.72, and that prior NRC approval of these changes were not required. Facility changes performed in 2007 were approved in a separate letter dated April 30, 2008, which closed TAC L32670.

Upon issuance of this letter TAC L32606 is considered CLOSED.
