The two forms you sent are NOT all that was needed and they are not complete. Also, I cannot receive this information by email, but **must have hard copies with original signatures on these forms** sent to USNRC, ATTN: DNMS, 475 Allendale Road, King of Prussia, PA 19406.

Please make sure your cover letter references License No. 06-31314-01, Docket No. 030-37776 and Control No. 142479

Below the lines of ***asterisks*** at the end of this email are some of the detailed paragraphs from my email sent July 17. In summary, you must provide:

all of Table 3.b

- Table 3B must name the supervising RSO as well as the license number under which work experience was gained. This section listing the supervising RSO [for the 10 CFR 35.(b)(1)(ii) required full year of supervised experience] is in the box at the top of page B-3. Also, please note that the page B-2 you submitted shows only 5 months of supervised experience.

all of Table 3.c

In the box continuing Table 3.c on page B-4, he did not name the supervising individual for the rad safety/regulatory issues/emergency procedures. This individual may be the same individual or a different individual from the supervising RSO listed in Table 3.b.

the completed and signed Part II - Preceptor Attestation.

- this starts on page B-4 and finishes on page B-5, and must be signed by the preceptor RSO who is attesting that Dr. Knox has the training documented in Tables 3.a, 3.b and 3c and is capable of performing the duties of the RSO. This could be the supervising RSO but does not have to be.
- the name of the individual and the license number on which the individual is an RSO must be listed in the designated areas.
- the individual must SIGN, date, and provide a telephone number on the preceptor statement.

Option 3. Structured Educational Program for Proposed Radiation Safety Officer. This requires the proposed applicant to fill out Part 3.a. document the minimum 200 hours of classroom and laboratory training [10 CFR 35.50(b)(1)(i)] AND Part 3.b. the supervised one full year of radiation safety work experience [document the 7 experience areas, showing the location/license number and dates of that work experience; this section continues to the top of the following page and requires the name of the supervising individual who is an RSO and the license number under which the supervising individual is named as an RSO and the medical uses for which the supervising user is an RSO][10 CFR 35.50(b)(1)(ii)] AND Part 3.c documenting that the proposed RSO has been provided training specific to the medical uses for which he wishes to be named RSO, provided by a supervising RSO and listing the license number on which the supervising RSO is listed as an RSO [10 CFR 35.50(e)] AND the Part II - Preceptor Attestation must be filled out by the preceptor RSO.

Dr. Knox appeared to select this third option.

He checked Box 3.

He filled in Table 3.a.

He did not fill in Table 3.b and did not name the supervising RSO and the license number under which work experience was gained. We must have this information in order to name him RSO under this option.

He did fill out table 3.c but he did not name the supervising RSO and the license number under which the 3.c training was obtained. We must have this information in order to name him RSO under this option.

He did not provide the Part II - Preceptor Attestation.

ALL of the above options require that the "Part II - Preceptor Attestation" be provided. This is required to be signed by each preceptor to cover the areas that each is attesting to. there are four sections to the Part II Preceptor Attestation. the first Section documents that the preceptor is attesting that the individual to be named RSO has completed the applicable training requirements; the Second Section confirms the preceptors understanding of the medical uses for which the proposed RSO has had training; the Third Section attests to the preceptor's opinion that the proposed RSO has sufficient radiation safety knowledge to be an RSO for the purposes required; and the Fourth Section states the preceptor's facility and license number under which the preceptor is named as RSO. The bottom of the page needs to be signed by the preceptor and provide the other requested information.

However, the preceptor attestation provided with the application is not complete: The first section does not check the Option for qualification to which the preceptor is attesting; the middle page of the preceptor attestation (page 5 of NRC Form 313A (RSO) containing the third section is missing; the fourth section is not filled out by the preceptor; and Dr. Knox signed the bottom of the form instead of the preceptor.

Please provide a hard copy, signed response either presenting the additional information needed to approve Dr. Knox as the Radiation Safety Officer for this license; or the Form 313A

(RSO) information required to propose a different individual as Radiation Safety Officer for this license.
