On a clear winter day, we can recognize small white clouds that come from the cooling tower. Most residents of this community are retirees from the North; however, I am originally from North Carolina. Most residents here are well educated people who are knowledgeable of nuclear power. Although I can't speak for them, I believe that most residents would highly favor an environmentally-clean nuclear plant addition to the Harris plant rather than an environmentally-dirty fossil fuel addition.
