Prairie island Indian Community Environmental Site Audit Needs List July 18, 2008

Note: The terms Prairie Island Sioux, the Prairie Island Mdewakanton Dakota Sioux, the Prairie Island Dakota Community, and the Prairie Island Community Council all have the same meaning: the elected governing body of the Prairie Island Indian Community.

Historic and Archaeological Resources

Please provide the following:

- 1. Published and unpublished reports, field or other notes, and articles pertaining to any research, studies, salvage operations, and surveys of archaeological, cultural, or historic sites within the boundaries of the Prairie Island Nuclear Generating Plant (PINGP). Any approvals or correspondence from the State Historic Preservation Office, (SHPO), the State Archaeologist, or the late 1960's early 1970's equivalent, related to the aforementioned surveys, studies, research, or salvage operations.
- 2. Data and/or reports resulting from any pre-construction vegetation surveys that may have been conducted within the boundaries of the PINGP.
- 3. Documentation or information related to the then-current traditional use of plants (vegetation) and sacred sites (including mounds), within the boundaries of the PINGP.
- 4. Documentation or information related to the disposition of any artifacts (including human remains) that may have been collected during any work related to archaeological sites within the boundaries of the PINGP.
- 5. Documentation or information related to the disposition of any artifacts or human remains identified during the construction of the PINGP.
- 6. Documentation or information related to the disposition of any artifacts or human remains identified during the operation of the PINGP.
- 7. Correspondence related to archaeological sites, especially to or from the Prairie Island Indian Community, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, the SHPO, or State Archaeologist, or any other individual or entity performing any research, studies, or salvage operations or surveys of any archaeological sites.
- 8. Documents or correspondence related to the Prairie Island Indian Community, the Prairie Island Dakota Community, the Prairie Island Community Council, the Mdewankanton Dakota, any Dakota or Sioux, or any other previous inhabitant or user of the lands.

- 9. Site plans for construction of PINGP, including plans for the cooling towers, and information pertaining to site preparation.
- 10. Pre-construction maps, delineating surface and/or sub-surface features.
- 11. Aerial photographs taken during the construction of the PINGP.
- 12. Documentation related to any efforts made to identify archaeological, cultural or historic sites within the boundaries of the PINGP.
- 13. Documentation related to any efforts made to identify archaeological, cultural or historic sites on areas designated for construction of any structure, road, or other improvement.
- 14. Documentation related to any efforts made to relocate any structure, road or other improvement as a result of any archaeological, cultural or historic sites identified within the boundaries of the PINGP.
- 15. Documentation related to the location or construction of any structure, road or other improvement that impacted, disturbed or destroyed any archaeological, cultural or historic sites identified within the boundaries of the PINGP.
- 16. Site plans for the proposed refurbishment activities (i.e., steam generator replacement), including: location of all buildings and associated infrastructure and utilities, and plans to determine whether archaeological sites might be present in the proposed area.

Socio-economic Factors

Please provide:

1. Information pertaining to the taxes paid to the City of Red Wing and Goodhue County, or any other jurisdiction from 1973 and 1974 until 2007.

Environmental Justice

Please provide:

- 1. Documentation or information pertaining to site selection for the PINGP (i.e., why Prairie Island was selected versus some other location on the Mississippi River).
- 2. Documentation related to NSP's original acquisition of the land associated with the PINGP.
- 3. Correspondence to or from the Prairie Island Indian Community pertaining to the proposed development of the PINGP.

- 4. Documents discussing potential impacts to the Prairie Island Indian Community and its resources from the PINGP.
- 5. Documents related to the 1979 steam generator tube rupture and subsequent radiological releases, monitoring results, and notification to the Prairie Island Indian Community.
- 6. Information pertaining to tritium releases within the vicinity of the Prairie Island Indian Community, water monitoring data, maps delineating monitoring sites, and any official correspondence to or from the Prairie Island Indian Community, the BIA, the Indian Health Service (IHS), MN Department of Health or the US Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC).
- 7. Copies of any independent health or cancer studies that may have been conducted in relation to the operation of the PINGP or transmission lines.
- 8. Map of the locations of all effluent monitoring stations within and outside the boundaries of the PINGP, a map of groundwater monitoring sites, and a summary of the results of the annual effluent monitoring reports for the last ten years.
- 9. Documentation that economic impacts to the Prairie Island Indian Community, as a result of an accident, were reviewed in the Severe Accident Mitigation Alternatives (SAMA) analysis including: the value of tribal members' home sites (1 acre), the value of the home, tribal members' loss of income, and the cost of re-establishing an Indian Tribe (which includes land acquisition, legal costs, and infrastructure development), and the cost of relocating the Prairie Island's business enterprises.
- 10. Documentation related to cumulative impacts to the Prairie Island Indian Community from the PINGP and associated facilities—Unit 1, Unit 2, transmission lines, and spent fuel storage facility.

Land-Use (Off-site)

Please provide:

- 1. Documents pertaining to Northern States Power's (now Xcel Energy) efforts to obtain an easement and/or Right of Way for Eggelston Road (now Sturgeon Lake Road), including correspondence with the Prairie Island Indian Community and the BIA.
- 2. Documents related to payments or other compensation for the Right of Way.
- 3. Documents pertaining to the assessed value of the Prairie Island Indian Community's land for the Right of way and/or easement proposal.

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
