Enclosed with this letter is the Annual Report on the Effectiveness of Training in the Nuclear Industry for Calendar Year 2007. This report is based on the NRC's (1) review of training-related issues derived from Human Factors Information System data, (2) observations of the INPO accreditation process, and (3) review of the results of operator licensing inspection and oversight activities. The report concludes that accredited training programs continue to meet the systems approach to training requirements contained in 10 CFR Parts 50 and 55. Although NRC monitoring has provided some evidence of areas that could be improved, overall, all indicators suggest that the industry is implementing training programs in accordance with the regulations.
