

Dear Sir;

This letter is to outline our discussions today with your office and the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT) outlining the chain of custody for a nuke gauges. When ATCS, PLC is assigned a project by VDOT that requires the use of a VDOT owned nuclear gauge, ATCS takes custody of that gauge and stores it in an approved location, provided by VDOT for the duration of the Job. During that time ATCS is responsible for the gauge until such a time that the gauge is returned to VDOT upon completion of the project. If the gage is damaged, stolen, or lost ATCS is the responsible party to report the incident to the NRC, VDOT and all other appropriate authorities upon discovery.
