SUBJECT

Control No. 317201 - Re - Amendment request (NRC License No. 34-29200-01MD) to authorize release for unrestricted use, the licensee's facility located at 628 Hebron Ave. Bldg. 4, Glastonbury, CT. The request is based on removal and transfer to another of the licensee's locations of use, authorized on the same subject license (131 Hartland St., East Hartford, CT), all remaining licensed material, followed by a detailed GM meter survey, as well as wipe survey (of 100 square centimeter areas) of both restricted and unrestricted areas. All wipes in the wipe survey showed removable activity to be well below NRC criteria for release of a facility for unrestricted use. The licensee confirmed that the only use of material at the subject facility was non-leaking sealed sources and short lived non-sealed radioactive materials. The sewer system was not used for disposal of radioactive materials.

SUMMARY

In a telephone conversation with Mr. Regits (in the absence of Mr. David Breuning) on this date, I related the following deficiencies in the amendment application by letter dated May 22, 2008:

1. The survey results in Attachment B did not document the units of measure for the readings of the GM survey meter.
2. Attachment C (NRC Form 314, Certificate of Disposition of Materials) was incomplete and should be resubmitted to include a) Licensee Name and Address; b) License Number; c) Docket Number; and d) License Expiration Date.
3. The referenced Attachment D was not received with the amendment application dated May 22, 2008. Mr. Regits related that only sealed sources were transferred directly by the licensee from their facility in Glastonbury, CT, to their facility in East Hartford, CT, as Attachment D (signed by the RSO) which will be submitted, will confirm. Also, the licensee was requested to provide a copy of a current leak test record for all sealed sources transferred, (having activities sufficient to require leak testing) which confirm the non-leaking status of the sources transferred.
