Hi Greg/Bill:

I am resending this e-mail as some of Staff's comments did not come through in the e-mail. Again, I wanted to thank you for the productive discussion we had between STP and NRC team members. I wanted to re-state what I heard in our March 19th meeting.

1. Greg Gibson mentioned that the discharge of groundwater from dewatering wells would flow into the main cooling reservoir. However, no definitive plan for discharge of stormwater/silty water from the excavation pit has been determined at this time.
2. Russ Kiesling has already contacted the USACE. STPNOC will be submitting a wetlands validation package to the USACE in the next 4 to 5 weeks. A draft map that will indicate perceived jurisdictional and non-jurisdictional wetlands is being prepared by Mr. Kiesling. This map will be provided with the validation package and STPNOC offered to provide a copy of the draft map to the NRC.
3. STPNOC will provide the NRC with a letter from the USACE regarding the Waters of the US determination for the MCR.
4. There is one drainage ditch that is about a mile long that the USACE is considering Waters of the US. According to Russ, this area will not be in the construction zone, but is within a lay down area. STPNOC is currently examining their options to minimize or avoid impacts to this wetland.
5. According to Bill Mookhoek, STPNOC's goal is to make a decision on the excavation and dewatering plan by June 2008, thus providing the NRC with the information necessary for the DEIS analysis through the RAI process.
