The license is amended to:

1. Add authorization to export Australian, Canadian, and EURATOM-obligated material;
2. Reduce the quantity authorized for export by 25,000.0 kilograms of uranium-235 (U-235) and reduce the total quantity of uranium by 500,000.0 kilograms; and
3. Remove the Maanshan Units 1 and 2 site locations as an ultimate consignee.

The new cumulative total quantity of LEU authorized for export is 42,500.0 kilograms of U-235 contained in 850,000.0 kilograms of uranium.

All other conditions remain unchanged.

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
