
The subject deficiency was initially reported to NRC-OIE Inspector R. V. Crlenjak on May 6, 1981 in accordance with 10 CFR 50.55(e) as NCR WBN SWP 8127. TVA considers 10 CFR Part 21 applicable to this deficiency. Interim reports were submitted on June 5, September 15, October 28, and December 16, 1981 and February 17, 1982. Our final report was submitted on April 16, 1982.

In that final report, TVA committed to have Bergen-Paterson perform a review of support calculations (on a sampling basis) by June 30, 1982. However, as discussed with Inspector D. Quick on September 22, 1982, this commitment was not met. TVA now anticipates this review to be completed by November 1, 1982.
