On December 30, 1981 in my letter to H. R. Denton, we provided a submittal which satisfied the Sequoyah Nuclear Plant unit 2 Operating License (DPR-79) Condition 2.C(16).r.1. This submittal provided a functional description of the upgraded capabilities for the meteorological program and contained a TVA commitment to report, quarterly, the calculated data unavailability for each primary meteorological measurement system for each operating nuclear plant. Since the first quarter of 1982, TVA has reported the data availability for Sequoyah. This information was also provided for the Browns Ferry Nuclear Plant and Watts Bar Nuclear Plant.

Based upon the consistently high data availability maintained through previous report periods, TVA intends to discontinue submitting meteorological data availability reports. The availability statistics will be available for review upon NRC's request.

Listed below are the Central Emergency Control Center (CECC) meteorological data availability statistics covering the period April 1 through June 30, 1983. These figures are an end-to-end assessment of the Environmental Data Station data collection, transmission, reception, and storage in the CECC computer system.

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


