Dear COL Skvorak:

This is in reference to your letter dated June 25, 2008 requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 19-11831-03. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. The method for listing the maximum amount of material allowed on a license for sealed sources has changed such that all materials listed need a specific maximum activity allowed under the license. This value needs to be added whenever the license is being amended as initiated by letter dated June 25, 2008. Please provide the maximum activity per source and maximum total activity you wish to be licensed for items 6.B., 6.C. and 6.D. of your license.
2. The values submitted in item 1, will change the values that are listed on your Certification of Financial Assurance. Please submit a new Certification of Financial Assurance (CFA) to support the license change. If the CFA can not be completed in a timely manner (30 days), please state so and a financial assurance licensing action will be opened to track completion.
