SUBJECT: William S. Lee Nuclear Station Consultation Report

Consistent with the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) established between the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) on February 20, 2007 to implement Section 657, **DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY CONSULTATION**, the Energy Policy Act (EPA) of 2005, DHS agreed to provide information to NRC concerning the potential vulnerabilities of and threat to the location of the proposed utilization facility from terrorist attack.

On March 3, 2008, NRC notified DHS that it had accepted the William S. Lee Nuclear Station combined license application for Units 1 and 2 for docketing and began its review. Consistent with the MOU, DHS had 90 working days to conduct its review and provide a report of its findings to NRC.

DHS has completed its review and enclosed is the New Reactor Consultation Report on the William S. Lee Nuclear Station, proposed to be built in Gafney, South Carolina. The New Reactor Consultation Report satisfies the requirement of Section 657 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005. DHS participants will be available to discuss the findings if desired.
