WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT UNITS 1 AND 2 - FAILURE OF SAFETY-RELATED WESTINGHOUSE GATE VALVES - NCR WEN NEB 8013 AND IE BULLETIN 81-02 -TENTH INTERIM REPORT

The subject condition was initially reported to NRC-OIE Inspector R. W. Wright on October 31, 1980 in accordance with 10 CFR 50.55(e). Interim reports were submitted on December 1, 1980 and March 23, June 3, September 1, and November 18, 1981 and February 11, April 13, July 22, and October 22, 1982. This report also constitutes our latest response to IE Bulletin 81-02 on Watts Bar. We expect to provide our next report by June 22, 1983. TVA considers 10 CFR Part 21 applicable to this nonconformance.

The required field modifications have been completed for unit 1. Modifications for the unit 2 valves are still in progress. Westinghouse has stated that the nature of the modilications is such that the drawing revisions required for closure of the NCR will be submitted upon completion of the field work. Our final report on this matter will be provided upon completion of the field work and receipt of revised drawings showing the modifications.
