Subject: Report Nos. 50-390/82-27 and 50-3 2-24

This refers to the special safety inspection conducted by Mr. F. S. Cantrell and others of this office on  $Ju!_y 27$ . through August 6, 1982, of activities authorized by NRC Construction Permit Nos. CPPR-91 and CPPR-92 for the Watts Bar facility. Our preliminary findings were discussed with Mr. R. M. Pierce, OEDC, Watts Bar Project Manager, at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors.

During the inspection it was found that certain activities under your license appeared to deviate from commitments to the Commission and have safety significance. This item is identified in the Notice of Deviation enclosed herewith as Appendix A. Please provide us in writing within 30 days of your receipt of this letter your comments including a description of corrective actions that have been or will be taken, corrective actions which will be taken to avoid further deviations, and the date your corrective actions were or will be completed.

In addition to the need for corrective action regarding these specific deviations, we are concerned about the implementation of your management control systems for ensuring that commitments made to the NRC are implemented, and that once implemented, the commitments remain in effect until relief from the commitments is granted by the NRC. Accordingly, in your reply you should describe, in particular, those actions taken or planned to improve the effectiveness of your management control systems in this regard.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosures will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room unless you not fy this office, by telephone, within ten days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within thirty days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 2.790(b)(1).
