PURPOSE: NRC staff from the Office of Nuclear Security and Incident
Response (NSIR), Division of Security Policy, will discuss with the
NEI and licensees a proposed supplement to recent NRC generic
communication RIS-2008-10. This RIS discussed advance
planning by the nuclear industry for forthcoming firearms
background checks of armed security personnel. The supplement
to the RIS discusses changes in the applicability of the firearms
background checks and is intended to assist in advance planning
