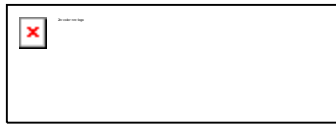

Monica,

Sorry for delay in getting back to you. In response to your questions:

- 1) We are using the same license condition that the Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) is using with their licenses and are using the same date: October 1, 2008.
- 2) Any new license with radioactive materials in quantities greater than those listed in Table 1 of NRC Order EA-07-305 will need to meet the fingerprinting requirements before the license is issued. We are working closely with the DSHS concerning the license language for fingerprinting and any license condition concerning this will use the same wording as those issued by the DSHS.

I am just following up to a call I made to you last week. I am reviewing the CEQ Fingerprinting license condition and have a few questions.

1) In the license condition it states that the licensee shall complete implementation of said requirements by DATE. What date are you actually listing here? Are you listing the date implemented by DHS since both licensee are coming to you from DHS and are already in the process of implementing the fingerprinting requirements?

2) What license condition is TXCEQ going to use for future licensee's that will have radioactive materials in quantities greater than those listed in Table 1 of NRC Order EA-07-305? Or is TXCEQ committed to not issuing a new license to a licensee until they have met the fingerprinting requirements established in NRC Order EA-07-305?
