Additional changes were made as a result of an NRC Operational Readiness Review performed on May 15, 2008 which were submitted on June 26, 2008. Approval of the request was granted by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) in a letter dated July 11, 2008 (Reference 2). In the letter granting this request, the NRC requested final page changes for the Standard Practices Procedure Plan for the Protection of Classified Matter at the National Enrichment Facility to be submitted within 30 days.

Enclosed is a complete copy of the Standard Practices Procedure Plan for the Protection of Classified Matter at the National Enrichment Facility that includes all attachments.
