Dear Mr. Ellis:

By letter dated July 22, 2008, you submitted a request for the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to amend License SUB-1010 for the Sequoyah Fuels Corporation site in Gore, Oklahoma. As stated in your request, the proposed changes are necessary to eliminate redundancy or conflict between the current requirements of the license and the Reclamation Plan, or are administrative to reflect current conditions.

The NRC staff has completed its acceptance review of your request to amend your license and identified no significant administrative omissions or major technical deficiencies. Therefore, this request has been accepted for formal review. Based on our acceptance review and current review schedules, we anticipate completing our review by the end of February 2009. This date could change, depending on the findings of our technical review, urgent assignments, or other factors. We will promptly communicate any significant changes to this schedule.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice for Domestic Licensing Proceedings and Issuance of Orders," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records
