SUMMARY (Continue on Page 2) <b>NRC Attendees: Larry Campbell, Shana Helton</b>  <p>The purpose of the call was to discuss the logistics regarding NAC's response to a letter dated 7/22/2008 from Bill Brach to NAC regarding the spent fuel storage cask security assessments. A similar letter was sent to the other major cask vendors (Holtec, EnergySolutions, and TransNuclear ). The letter stated that the NRC did not identify a need for any additional security measures based on the results of the security assessments. The letter gave the vendors the option of coming in to meet to discuss the staff's security assessment results in a non-public workshop, as information pertaining to the security assessments is sensitive.</p> <p>Staff advised NAC that NEI (Everett Redmond) has offered to coordinate the four vendor's response to the letter.</p>
