The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has begun the review of the Combined Operating License Application (COLA) for Entergy Operations Inc.'s (EOI's) new nuclear power plant (Unit 3) at its Grand Gulf Nuclear Station (GGNS) site in Claiborne County, Mississippi. A copy of the COLA including the Environmental Report can be found at <http://www.nrc.gov/reactors/new-licensing/col/grand-gulf.html> under the Applicant Documents, Grand Gulf 3 COLA heading. The simplified schedule for the NRC's environmental review is attached. Note that the NRC environmental review team is planning to visit the proposed plant site during the week of June 16, 2008, and conduct a public scoping meeting on June 19, 2008 in Port Gibson, MS. EPA and NRC management have agreed that we should inform you and involve your regional staff in the COLA reviews at the earliest opportunity.
