
Dear Mr. O'Reilly:

Please refer to my letter to you dated April 25, 1984, which contained a supplemental response to Inspection Report Nos. 50-259/83-53, -260/83-53, -296/83-53, -327/83-27, -328/83/27, -390/83-49, -391/83-38, -438/83-30, -439/83-30 for our Browns Ferry, Sequoyah, Watts Bar, and Bellefonte Nuclear Plants. In our supplemental response to Violation 1, under item 4 "Corrective Steps Which Will be Taken to Avoid Further Violations," we indicated a policy statement will be developed and issued by May 31, 1984. However, this policy statement will be delayed and will not be issued until June 14, 1984. This matter was discussed between Floyd Cantrell of your staff and Mike Hellums of my staff on May 30, 1984.
