Written Statement - Atomic Safety and Licensing Board

1. The cost to TVA rate payers of the Bellefonte Nuclear Plants is excessive and would increase energy costs with much less benefit than alternative energy sources such as solar and fewer jobs than a concerted effort for energy efficiency and demand response.
2. With droughts predicted to meet or exceed last summer's severe water shortages, draining the Tennessee River further for nuclear cooling towers is unacceptable to those of us upstream.
