Hi Tami,

A couple things in regard to the GG Audit:

1. In previous discussions, a request was made on your end for the RAD DATA Packages to be available during the audit week. We need some clarification on our end in regard to what specifically the Staff is requesting in terms of RAD DATA packages?
2. A question was raised on Permitting (ER 1.2) – specifically the request was to identify the 401 cert requirement in Table 1.2-201. This request was from Lance Vail and I believe you conveyed the question to us because Lance was not available. We pointed to pages 1 – 8 (of ER 1.2) as identifying the 401 cert requirement. Have you had a chance to talk with Lance Vail on this? Please let us know if anything more is needed?
3. New & Significant – I would like to schedule the N&S Briefing Conference Call for Monday, June 2, at 3:00 EDT (right after our 2:00 EDT call). Can you check to see if this works on your end? I believe we will be referencing a previously docketed presentation. I will let you know the ADAMS numbers as soon as I confirm this.
 - a. Can you let me know who from your end who will be participating in the N&S Briefing call (Monday, June 2, 3:00 EDT)?
 - b. With the N&S Files ready for viewing next Tuesday, June 3 - Can you let us know who from the Staff will be going to the Germantown offices to view the N&S Files and when they will be coming? We just need to be sure to have staff available at the Germantown offices on these days. The Richland office is not a concern in terms of who will be there and when, as there is constant office staff coverage at this location.
