Dear Members of Grand Gulf Review Team and Other Interested Parties:

Although this message is primarily intended for the Grand Gulf site audit attendees, I am sending to the entire review team and management as FYI. Entergy has offered to provide reviewers with an opportunity to review the New and Significant Documents for the Grand Gulf COL review in advance of our site audit. The volumes will be available at the Germantown office of Enercon (the primary contractor for Entergy's COLA). I do not yet have the address, but they tell me it is about 12 miles from headquarters. The documents will be available during working hours beginning on June 3.

If you are attending the site audit, I would appreciate it if you could let me know of your availability those two weeks (ie. between June 3 and June 13, which is the last working day before we depart for site audit). We have the flexibility of going over any time during those two weeks, but if it works out, some of us might arrange to drive over together (govt vehicle). Of course, the time that each reviewer may wish to spend looking at the documents will probably vary according to review area and whether many of their issues were resolved or not; therefore, carpooling may not work out. But we can play it by ear.

The ground rules are simple. There will be one hard copy available of the entire set of documents. No electronic copies will be available at the preview, (although electronic copies will be available during the site audit in Jackson.) No photocopies will be allowed, but you are free to make all the handwritten notes you wish. Enercon would like a heads up that you are on your way... maybe day before or morning of.

I know June is an extremely busy month; however, I really encourage everyone to try to work this in (especially those for whom the new and significant review might be problematic). The same offer is being made to the PNNL team, so I encourage you to interact with your counterpart in this effort.

I appreciate all your work on this. The review for COLs referencing ESPs is very heavy at the front end. However, if we hit the review hard in the beginning, the toughest part will be behind us (we hope). I will be in touch with site audit attendees in a couple of days to pass along Enercon's address, the phone number for calling ahead and any other specifics I have neglected to mention in this message. If any others who are in receipt of this message wish to have that information as well, please let me know and I will be glad to include you in the follow up message.

Let me know if there is anything I can do to help you in this effort.
