SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF AUGUST 7, 2008, PUBLIC MEETING REGARDING THE
VICTORIA COUNTY STATION COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION

On August 7, 2008, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a Category 3 public meeting at the Community Center Dome, in Victoria City, Texas. The purpose of the meeting was to inform the public of the NRC review process for the Victoria County Station, Units 1 and 2 Combined License (COL) application that Exelon planned to submit in early September, 2008. The meeting agenda is provided as Enclosure 1 and the NRC presentation slides are provided as Enclosure 2 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management Systems (ADAMS) Accession Number ML082260497).

This meeting summary (ML082280130) and the presentation materials distributed at the meeting are available through ADAMS as a package at Accession Number ML082280112. ADAMS is the system that provides text and image files of NRC's public documents. By letter dated December 20, 2007, Exelon Generation Company, LLC, in response to the NRC's Regulatory Information Summary 2007-08, informed the NRC that it intended to submit a COL application for Victoria County Station, Units 1 and 2 no later than September, 2008. Based on the information provided by Exelon, the NRC scheduled a public outreach meeting in Victoria City, Texas, to discuss the COL application review process and to provide information to the public on when and how to participate in the review process.

Staff from the Office of New Reactors provided meeting opening remarks, an overview of the NRC organization and mission, and an overview of the process for review of the Victoria County Station, Units 1 and 2 COL application. NRC staff presented information on various elements of the review process which included the safety review, the environmental review process, the hearing process, and the post-licensing construction inspection process. NRC staff identified when and how the public may participate in the review process. In addition, the NRC provided a very high level summary of what it expected would be included in the Victoria County Station, COL application which will reference the economic simplified boiling water reactor (ESBWR) design that is currently under review by the NRC. The NRC staff indicated that should the Victoria County Station, Units 1 and 2 COL application successfully pass the acceptance review, it could be officially docketed as an application for review. In addition, the NRC staff indicated that it could not issue licenses for Victoria County Station, Unit 1 or Unit 2 without first certifying that the ESBWR design, which is currently under review, meets NRC regulations.

The staff indicated that a public webpage would be created for the Victoria County Station, Units 1 and 2 COL application to assist the public in its access to the application, the application review and associated schedule information.

The staff addressed comments and questions from the public at the meeting after the presentation. The attendance list is attached (Enclosure 3 ADAMS Accession Number ML082260498). Several public meeting feedback forms (Enclosure 4 ADAMS Accession Number ML082260499) were also received. (These two enclosures are non-public because personal information is contained in them.) Each of these feedback forms will be considered as the agency schedules additional public meetings for the Victoria application.
