TVA'S DECEMBER REPORT ON THE STATUS OF INVESTIGATIONS OF ALLEGATIONS - ALL  
NUCLEAR PLANTS

The purpose of this letter is to provide TVA's monthly report regarding the investigations of open allegations as we committed in our June 27, 1986 letter to you.

Enclosure 1 is a list of allegations that are being investigated, the present status, and updated summary sheets for each of the 47 allegations.

Enclosure 2 is the ECP investigation reports for concerns that were closed in December. They include RII-86-A-0210, RII-84-A-187, and RII-86-A-0085.
