FINAL REPORT DISTRIBUTION PLAN FOR EMPLOYEE CONCERNS

This letter is to delineate TVA's method of notifying TVA employees of the opening of the Employee Concerns Special Program (ECSP) review stations and "hot lines," and to request the NRC's assistance in the completion of this process.

Prior to opening the review stations, TVA will notify current employees through the normal TVA press which includes the INSIDE TVA newsletter, the NUCLEAR DISPATCH, and other special flyers as deemed appropriate.

However, out of approximately 4700 people who were employed in the Watts Bar Project during the May 1, 1985 through February 1, 1986 period, there are approximately 1600 who are no longer employees of TVA. TVA will notify these former employees through the mail.

As was discussed by W. R. Brown, TVA, and B. K. Singh of your staff, in order to assure that all employees who may have expressed concerns in the ECSP will be notified, we must ask that you be a part of the notification process.

We propose to supply you with two lists, one being the list of current employees who will be notified as mentioned previously, and the second list being that of TVA employees who were employed in the Watts Bar Project during the period noted above. In order to complete the notification process and maintain the concerned individual's (CI) anonymity, we request that the NRC mail the information to be supplied by TVA to these people who are not covered on the lists supplied by TVA.
