WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT (WBN) - 10 CFR 73(c)(9) - NRC REQUEST FOR  
VEHICULAR BOMB THREAT INFORMATION RELATED TO PROTECTION AGAINST MALEVOLENT  
USE OF VEHICLES AT NUCLEAR POWER PLANTS (TAC NOS. M90696)

This letter provides a summary description of the proposed vehicle control measures for WBN as required by 10 CFR 73.55(c)(7) and the results of the vehicle bomb comparison as required by 10 CFR 73.55(c)(8). By letter dated November 30, 1994, TVA requested an exemption from the schedule requirement of 10 CFR 73.55(c)(10) that would have required implementation of the land vehicle bomb control program at Watts Bar by the date of receipt of the Operating License. Implementation of the land vehicle bomb program at Watts Bar will be in accordance with the scheduler requirements as stipulated in 10 CFR 73.55 (c)(9).

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
