Request for correction to typographical error in the Certificate of Compliance for the Model ES-3100 Shipping Container, USA/9315/B(U)F-96

By a letter dated July 7, 2008, the NRC issued Revision 8 of the ES-3100 Certificate of Compliance. In a review of Revision 8, it was discovered that a typographical error was made in Table 2. In the first column of Table 2, *Uranium Enrichment (weight percent U-235)*, the entry for the less than or equal to 60 percent category was mistyped. The symbol for “less than or equal to” was left off.

The Y-12 National Security Complex has a shipment planned for this week that is in the less than or equal to 60 percent enrichment category, and cannot do that until this typographical error is formally acknowledged. Therefore, we are asking for a letter authorization that specifies the entry in question in Table 2 of Revision 8 should be “ ≤ 60 ,” effectively correcting this error.
