Thank you for your letter dated July 9, 2008, which provided comments and recommendations on the use of CsCl in the U.S. Since I couldn't find a responding e-mail to you in your letter, I am responding to you via your company's website since I wanted you to be sure to receive timely and latest information on an upcoming NRC Workshop on Security and Continued Use of Cesium-137 Chloride Sources to be held in Rockville, MD on September 29-30, 2008.

The NRC is conducting this public meeting to solicit early and active public input on major issues associated with the use of certain forms of cesium chloride (CsCl) sources currently used by NRC- and Agreement State-licensees.

Your interest and comments on this Federal Register Notice and Issues Paper are important to the NRC in order to fully and adequately foster discussion amongst stakeholders about the issues and alternatives before any potential future actions by NRC or the Agreement States are initiated. NRC is continuing to seek input from all stakeholders, including professionals like yourself, the user community, and the general public.
