The subject deficiency was initially reported to NRC-OIE Inspector  
P. E. Fredrickson on May 11, 1984 in accordance with 10 CFR 50.55(e) as NCR  
WBN MEB 8415. Below is a supplemental final report for unit 2.

The date of December 31, 1984 for completion of corrective actions indicated  
in our final report on this matter was not met. A review of unit 2  
commitments has identified that the commitment to install unit 2 fire  
detectors has not been completed but that work is continuing under ECN 4872.

The corrective action on this matter will be completed by February 1, 1986.
