As you are aware from my discussions with Mr. Stello last night, contractual negotiations between TVA and QTC concerning the continuation of QTC support in this effort have, to this point, proven unsuccessful. My call to Mr. Stello was the earliest practical time in which I felt that notification under the terms of the order could be made.

I have taken steps to ensure that removal, destruction, or other actions which could compromise the integrity of the information contained in such records are prohibited.
