NUCLEAR POWER - ORGANIZATION AND SENIOR MANAGEMENT CHANGE

TVA is making changes in its Muclear Power program as part of ongoing efforts to improve the organization's focus on single-point accountability and increase our emphasis on the project management approacu. In keeping with this objective, Mr. Richard F. Wilson, who has more than 35 years of industry experience, has been selected to fill the newly created position of Vice President, New Projects, in Nuclear Power and given the overall responsibility for the Bellefonte and Watts Bar nuclear projects. Mr. Wilson will provide the overall management and direction to supervise the functional entities necessary to complete Watts Bar unit 1 and prepare it to be turned over to the Nuclear Power Production organization for operation. Mr. Wilson also has responsibility for Watts Bar unit 2 and Bellefonte units 1 and 2 as they are scheduled for completion.

In addition to the above change, Mr. Mark O. Medford, who has 18 years of nuclear power related experience and extensive background in all aspects of nuclear licensing, has been named Vice President and Nuclear Technical Director. Mr. Medford will assume the responsibility of providing general management and oversight of nuclear licensing, nuclear fuels, operational experience review, special projects, and industry program coordination.

Mr. Medford will report to TVA on June 5, 1989, and Mr. Wilson will report to TVA on June 19, 1989.
