The subject deficiency was initially reported to NRC-OIE Inspector M. Thomas on July 14, 1980 in accordance with 10 CFR 50.55(e). Our final report was submitted on August 13, 1980.

In our final report TVA committed to complete corrective actions by December 5, 1980. Unit 1 work is complete, however, unit 2 work is not. These dates were scheduled according to the fuel load dates in effect at that time. Because of the subsequent slip in the fuel load dates, the completion dates for this work have been delayed. As discussed with Inspector R. V. Crlenjak on January 8, 1982, TVA is now making a commitment date of unit 2 fuel load for completion of this corrective action. This will prevent fuel load delays from affecting our commitment dates on items, such as this, that are scheduled to be completed before fuel load.
