On March 10, 1986, I submitted a Revised Corporate Nuclear Performance Plan (CNPP). As stated in my cover letter of that submittal, the progress of implementation of the Revised CNPP would be monitored and when progress was made, I would provide this additional information to the NRC staff. The enclosed Revision 1 of the Revised CNPP provides a progress report and a response to B. J. Youngblood's letter dated May 1, 1986. Enclosure 1 provides the revised Volume 1 pages with instructions for updating your current volume. For ease of NRC staff review, Appendix 7 of the enclosure provides a cross-referenced index to Revised CNPP changes which are in response to the questions in the May 1, 1986 Youngblood letter.

I am also submitting today a revised Volume 2 of the Revised CNPP, the Revised Sequoyah Nuclear Performance Plan.

I solicit an accelerated review of Volumes 1 and 2 to be compatible with my concept that the TVA management and employees can complete actions necessary for restart earlier than the announced schedule of January 1987 for restart of Sequoyah Unit 2. Our staff's detail planning schedules are being integrated and I hope that TVA and the NRC staff can be ready to brief the Commission in September concerning progress and milestones to Sequoyah restart.

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


TVA will continue to monitor the progress of implementation of the Revised CNPP and provide additional information to the NRC staff as needed.
