WATTS BAR NUCLEAR PLANT UNITS 1 AND 2 - EFFECTS OF TORNADO DEPRESSURIZATION ON CLASS 1B EQUIPMENT - WBRD-50-390/86-08, WBRD-50-391/86-07 - CHANGE OF SCHEDULE FOR NEXT REPORT

The subject deficiency was initially reported to NRC-Region II Inspector Al Ignatonis on December 18, 1985 in accordance with 10 CFR 50.55(e) as SCR WBN EEB 8563. Interim reports were submitted on January 15, and March 14, 1986. Our next report was scheduled for submittal on or about June 30, 1986. As discussed with Bob Carroll on June 26, 1986, TVA is still evaluating this deficiency to determine the impact on safe operation of the plant. We have therefore rescheduled our final report to be provided to NRC by October 3, 1986.
