

**SEQUOYAH NUCLEAR PLANT (SQN) - QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAM FOR

This letter serves as notification, as required by 10 CFR 72.140(d), that we intend to apply our previously approved 10 CFR 50, Appendix B, Quality Assurance Program to activities at the independent spent fuel storage installation (ISFSI) to be constructed at the SQN site. The TVA Nuclear Quality Assurance Plan (TVA-NQA-PLN89-A), Revision 8, was submitted to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, under Docket Nos. 50-259, 50-260, 50-296, 50-327, 50-328, 50-390, 50-391, 50-438, and 50-439 on September 2, 1998. The TVA-NQA-PLN89-A, Revision 8, was approved in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(a)(3).
