This amendment also authorizes total possession limits on the license for all sealed sources covered by your license, based on the information provided by Mark R. Schlotzhauer, CPESC, Civil Engineer, during our request by telephone conversation on August 15, 2008. This amendment deletes former License Condition 13 which addressed possession limits, but is no longer needed since possession limit are now addressed in License Items 8.A. and 8.B.
