SUBJECT: REPORT NO. 50-390/83-19 AND 50-391/83-15

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Messrs. C. R. McFarland and L. H. Jackson of this office on May 31 - June 3, 1983, of activities authorized by NRC Construction Permit Nos. CPPR-91 and CPPR-92. Our preliminary findings were discussed with Mr. R. M. Pierce, Project Manager, at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection and our findings are discussed in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors.

During the inspection, it was found that certain activities under your license appear to violate NRC requirements. These items and references to pertinent requirements are listed in the Notice of Violation enclosed herewith as Appendix A. Elements to be included in your response are delineated in Appendix A.

During the inspection, it was found that certain activities under your license appeared to deviate from your commitments to the Commission and have safety significance. This item is identified in the Notice of Deviation enclosed herewith as Appendix B. Please provide us in writing within 30 days of your receipt of this letter your comments, including a description of corrective actions that have been or will be taken, corrective actions which will be taken to avoid further deviations, and the date your corrective actions were or will be completed.

In addition to the need for corrective action regarding these specific violation, we are concerned about the effectiveness of your management control systems and quality assurance program that permitted its occurrence. Consequently, your response should describe in particular those actions taken or planned to improve the effectiveness of your management control systems and quality assurance program relative to this project and for similar activities at other projects.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter will be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room unless you notify this office, by telephone, within ten days of the date of this letter and submit written application to withhold information contained therein within thirty days of the date of this letter. Such application must be consistent with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.790(b)(1).
