Dear Ms. Barnes,

The natural uranium we intend to export is to be delivered at the conversion facility owned by Cameco, Inc. The material is stored on site at the conversion facility prior to its delivery to one of our customers under a sales agreement. Prior to delivery to a customer, the material is held in an inventory account as natural uranium on the behalf of Mestena Uranium, LLC. Once delivery is made, title of the material is transferred to the customer via a book transfer. Our typical customer is a U.S. nuclear utility. At that point, the customer may maintain the material as natural uranium in their inventory account or they proceed with further processing for fuel for their nuclear reactors.
