For example, in STP's characterization of the demographics of the area, they did not identify any Census block areas with a concentrated population of Asian peoples. However, Palacios, the community closest to the proposed site, has an area the city calls "Little Vietnam" because of the large number of Vietnamese people who immigrated to Southern Texas in the early eighties. A second example of the STP ER's lack of completeness would be their lack of relevant road data. STP's contractors were unable to characterize any of the roads surrounding the proposed site in any meaningful manner (LOS, condition, etc.). In general, we felt the level of investigation performed by the socioeconomic authors was not sufficient. Over 80 percent of the references made in the relevant sections were performed via internet searches, rather than through personal contacts within the potentially affected communities. Finally, the level of the STP ER's technical writing did not reach our standard of quality. There was a general lack of citations within the socioeconomic and environmental sections, tables were without titles or reference, and often tables and charts did not have axes labeled or defined in terms of their units of measure.

Hope this helps. This is drawn from my personal notes taken while reviewing the document.
